- ☞ Affiliation with a complete postal address, 12 point, in italics,
- ☞ If affiliations of the co-authors are not the same, they should be listed in succession.
- ☞ The e-mail address of the corresponding author, 10 point, in italics.
- ☞ Abstract and key words, 10 point
- ☞ Main text: Font Times New Roman 12 point, 1.5 spacing, tabulation 0.5 cm
- ☞ Tables and figures should be inserted directly in the Word file.

The town of Toruń is located on the West-North of Poland, about 200 km from Warsaw. It is a co-capital of a Kujawsko-Pomorskie Province. The population of the town is about 210,000.

TRANSPORTATION

Warsaw has direct connection with majority of Europe's capitals, both with traditional Airlines and low-costs. Many low-costs with very competitive prices (e.g. Ryan Air, Easy Jet, Wizz Air, Sky Europe) also operate to regional capitals located not far from Toruń (Poznań, Gdańsk, Bydgoszcz).

Please remember that opening of the Conference is Thursday, 6.00 PM. You should reach Toruń by train/bus from Warsaw, Gdańsk, Bydgoszcz or from Poznań. It is strongly recommended that you should book an early morning flight to Warsaw or Poznań, so you can reach Toruń on time.

The town is easy to reach from Warsaw (Okęcie – F. Chopin Airport) (by train 2,5 hours or by bus 3,5 hours), Gdańsk (by train 3,0 hours), Bydgoszcz (by train 1,0 hours) or from Poznań (by train 2,0 hours). All trains are starting in Warsaw from Central Station (Warszawa Centralna). Link to train station provides Bus #175 (ticket is 2,4 zloty) from bus stop just opposite of Arrival Hall in Okęcie Airport. All the participants arriving to Toruń can take a bus #22 from Toruń Główny Railway Station. You should leave bus at third stop after crossing Vistula River. The hotel is located 300 m from Bus Stop. Tickets (2,0 zloty) can be obtained from kiosques located inside around Railway Station. It is possible to pay directly in the bus under request of 2,5 zloty (You need small change). You can also take a taxi to the Hotel (9–10 zloty). [1 Euro is approx. 4,0 zloty]
